Statement of historical significance and description of property:

A874

Large, ornate two and one-half story bungalow with two false dormers embellishing the front gable. Porch wraps around front and right side of the house with dressed cement block piers and square tapered pillars. Front window and door lights are elaborately leaded. Eaves are open with shape brackets and large boards. Sides of building shingled. Left side has a wall dormer with a flat roofed bay on ground floor. Narrow driveway.

This house is believed to have been built by the parents in law of Chester Mulkey. The Mulkey's were an early Yamhill County family who had a donation land claim on Highway 18.
