Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B10

1755 NW Baker Creek Road

This is a two story Italianate box, with flat hipped roof on paired decorative brackets and a wide frieze. Regular narrow 1/1 windows have architrave mouldings, and there is an Italianate bay window on the first floor east side. There are traces of a former porch on the center east side, a narrow central door over the first story door. Both doors have transoms and architrave mouldings. The upper has four lights and recessed panels, the lower has recessed panels only. Siding is novelty or drop siding with corner boards. The chimney is just off center. A one-story sloping gable roofed porch is attached at the rear and small shed is connected to this addition. Main house has a concrete foundation. The barn is a gambrel roofed dairy barn with board and batten siding. It is near collapse.
