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Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B1044

This one-story California mission style home is unique to the area. The house of stucco construction with multi-level walls on the east and west sides and a flat roof top. There is a polygonal by projecting on the northwest with a tile hipped roof. An angled projecting curved bay has a semi-circular arched main entry door with a shed roof cap on the bay. There area a variety of window types, all of which have lead muntins. To the west of the main entry is a twenty light fixed picture window above which is a shed tile roof; to the east is a 32 light two center point window accented by a shed tile overhang. Other window types area: diamond shaped window and two small two center pointed windows flanking the west stucco exterior end chimney that has three clay chimney pots. On the west is another cement porch that has a shed one-bay roof supported by two wood posts.
