Statement of historical significance and description of property:

## B112

This house sits facing squarely south toward the front of a large rectangular lot. The shape is rectangular. There are two stories with a raised basement which has an outside entrance. The roof is a street-facing gable with a lower hipped roof running the width of the house over the porch. Four square columns support the porch roof. Two shed dormers with 4 windows are on the east and west sides of the main roof. Five wooden brackets support the roof extension in front and rear. Weatherboard siding. An exterior chimney of white brick is flanked by 2 windows. Front door is off-center with small window to left and large one/one to right. Style is Bungalow. This house has been beautifully maintained inside and out.

Historical Comment: Stan Cellars (Former owner of 409 SW Elmwood) supplied the builder's name Allie Arthur. The building date of about 1916. he said that the first owner was Professor Freirichs of Linfield College, who lived in this house for many years until he retired around 1946. At one point afterward it was a fraternity house associated with Linfield. The present owner is also a Linfield professor.
