Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B113

This house sits facing squarely east on the south side of a large corner lot, rectangular in shape. Two stories over slightly raised basement which has outside entrance. A large gable roof facing sides of house with front facing shed dormer containing 5 one over one small windows. Five wooden brackets support roof overhang on each side. Wood shingle siding. Four heaving wood columns resting on white brick piers support roof over porch. The front door is off center. Two chimneys: one interior, white brick; one exterior of white brick with a straight side and a "Stair-step" side. Two small single-pane windows flank exterior chimney.

Craftsman/Bungalow style.

Historical Comment: Stan Cellars, who lived in this house for a long time, told me that Prof. Frierichs had this house built around 1916. The builder was Allie Arthur. Professor Freirichs lived next door (531 SW Bills) and rented this house to Professor Taylor (Linfield College) for almost 30 years. Everyone thought Professor Taylor owned it, but it was always rented.
