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Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B115

In the kitchen section of the house some newspapers of the 1870's were found in the wall when some work was done on the walls. Owner says another part of the ground floor is about 10 years older than this section. Lower floor has plank walls of 1 x 12's, and there's at least on 1 x 18. The second story was added about 1900.

The house has a high gable with boxed cornices. There is novelty siding on the ground floor and wider weatherboards on the second floor. Windows have plain tops and sides, but have lugsills.

There used to be a porch across the front of the building, but this has been replaced by a small stoop with a gable (eyebrow) roof.

Windows are sash 1/1, but at the south end of the second floor there are two windows which have 20 pane sash.
