Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B139

This is an L-shaped house of rural vernacular style. If faces north on a generous corner lot. It is two-story and has a cement foundation. The gable roof faces front on the main section and a portion faces east on the L-wing. There is a sloping roof over front portion supported by turned wooded posts and carved brackets. The house has weatherboard siding and looks to have been built about 1890-1900. Windows are double hung sash type. The house is in good condition.
