Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B203

- L-Shaped, one and one half story rural vernacular residence with cornice brackets and scroll work rake detail.
  - Jerkinhead roofline, crossgable
  - Enclosed rafters
  - Eave brackets
  - Stick design bargeboard (also, stick design around porch)
- Gable dormer on south and west sides
- Interior (central) chimney
- Plain corner boards
- Four inch horizontal wood siding
- Double hung windows
- Three-bay shed porch (enclosed roof ends)
- Four turned pillars
- Stick-design brackets
- Symmetrical entrance
  - Oval light on front door
  - Four panels on bottom of door
- Pier foundation
