Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B245

Full block city park with larger Atlas Cedar at southeast corner (another is diagonally across intersection at 1034 North Davis) and a large Western Red Cedar at southwest corner. Lindens and White Birch dominate the north edge along 12th Street. Entire park is in grass with four tennis courts and a minimal play area designated for activities.

In 1927, Mrs. William B. Smith, widow of hardware store's operator and real estate developer, gave this block to the City along with \$2,000 to develop it as a playground. She designated the Kiwanis Club to oversee the leveling and equipping. In 1929, the City conveyed the property to School District No. 40 and in 1971, the City and School District issued a memorandum of intent to cooperate in the maintenance of the playground.
