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Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B307

This is a small, one and one-half story bungalow of wood frame construction, made smaller in effect by the dense plantings around it. The roof is a medium gable with jerkin ends, and two tine dormers in front (east) also have jerkin head roofs, and arched, six-lighted casement windows. The front porch is set off center and has a segmental arched lintel and also a shallow, jerkin head roof. The rear (west) elevation includes a large, shed-roofed dormer. Elsewhere, ornamentation is slight and windows are few. The house is quite well-preserved in its original state, though an attached garage has been added at the southwest corner.
