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Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B325 – Demolished October 1987

A plain rake & frieze board surrounds one and one-half story T-shaped house with a low gable roof with moderate over-hang. The central & outside chimney were added later. There is Lap siding with corner boards. There are double hung one over one sash windows with cornice molding. The off-centered front door with cornice molding has one window. A long full-width front porch is partially enclosed. Square posts support its low hipped roof. The foundation is low & covered with skirting.

While this structure does not appear on site on the Sanborne Perris Fire Insurance Maps until 1912, the architecture indicates that it is far older. This suggests that the house may have been moved from another site.
