Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B358

Rural vernacular with Italianate bay, oriented east-west, facing west. Two-story, symmetrical, rooms added on at back and on north side at some time. Roof is composition shingles, high gable, later front porch with Tuscan columns, door in center. Addition on north side has brick chimney. Originally house rested on 1 x 5 blocks, now has two-foot brick blocks. Attached garage.

This house was built by Asa Gaunt, probably in the 1880's. At one time, the porch went all around the house, and there was a well underneath. (The addition on the north side is over the well). The inside walls are single thickness, made of very thick vertical boards, as the present owners discovered when cutting an archway between the living room and dining room.

Interesting house—should talk more to owners and see interior.
