Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B375

This is a two-story square box with colonial features, plus attic with a dormer window, composition roof, walls are 4-inch ship lap. Storm windows have been added on south side. Foundation is cement, and there is a basement. Two brick chimneys (interior). A porch with flared columns is across the entire front and part of the south side. There is a rectangular bay on the upper story on the north side with one window and roof with ornamented brackets. Lower windows have lintels. There is a slanted bay on south side with three windows, with stained and leaded glass panes on upper center window. There are two stained and leaded glass windows on the porch. Front steps are cement, with wrought iron railing. Lattice work covered the basement openings at front and sides.

Pleasant P. Wright, a confectioner, bought this property from W.C. Miller in 1908 for \$350.00. In 1912, he is listed at this address indicating that the house was built in the interim.
