Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B511 – Demolished 1994

This is a one story building with at least partial basement. The building is made of rough faced brick and concrete. The main part of the building is basically rectangular, with two extension to the east; one large gym extension with concrete walls, and one cafeteria extension with wood siding. The back side of the school is all concrete wall except for the lunch room section. Most of the windows are new aluminum double-hung. Some of the old windows remain, mostly in the rear of the building. There are flat arches of brick above the windows. The brick is laid in patterns above and to the side of the front entry-way. The foundation of this building is concrete. A new pre-fab library unit has been added to the south end, connected to the main building by a breezeway.

The roofline is straight with slightly raised interruptions and a shallow central gable. There is a belt course just beneath the roof line.

Columbus replaced and older, 3-story wood, Queen Anne School (McMinnville's 2nd School) built in 1892 when it was erected in 1930.
