Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B539 – Demolished 1990

A two-story structure. It appears that a wrap-around porch with boxed pillars has been enclosed with large plate glass windows. Other windows on the first floor are one-overone double-hung and upstairs three-over-one and one-over-one double-hung sash windows with cornice mouldings. A hip roof with exposed rafters and large overhang contains two central chimneys. Dropped siding and corner boards have been used.

An addition to the main part of the building include a basement. Foundation of main house is covered with wooden skirting.

The front of the house facing south Davis on the second floor has four large window sections: four-over-one, four-over-four, four-over-four, and four-over-one.

To the right of the front door is a leaded window four feet by two feet.

This structure appears to pre-date 1902 on the Sanborn maps; if so, it was changed considerably around 1928 and made into a private hospital. An old undated photo of the structure, showing it much as it appears today, is labeled "New Hospital, McMinnville, Oregon."
