Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B637

This one story gabled house has a symmetrical façade (north) with an outside brick chimney along its west elevation as well as a center brick chimney. Protecting the front porch is a one bay gable portico supported at its two corners by large tapered square columns rising from the stoop floor. The main structure and the porch gable have boxed cornices and eave returns in a simply classical revival style. Its frontispiece is plain, cut semi-elliptically. The front door has five light sidelights and to each side of the entrance are triple, ten-light, hinged casement windows. The house has a concrete foundation above which a water table and corner boards frame the bevel sided elevations.
