Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B662

The plan of this two story with one story wing forms and "L" shape with a shed addition on the rear (west) elevation. A hip roof porch fills the corner. Its steep gable roof has wide overhang with covered rafters and small frieze board, undetailed. The siding is "drop" (with corner boards). The regularly spaced windows are (single light) double hung with cornice moulding. The porch supports are narrow square wood columns with scroll cut brackets at the beams, forming two bays, one for the steps and the other filled with balustrade. A brick chimney is centered in the one story wing. Although some detailing is missing this structure remains in a near original state as an excellent example of rural vernacular architecture.
