Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B745

This is a simple “L” shaped structure featuring a broad sloping “A” shaped roofline which sweeps over the porch at the main (north) entrance. Two large wooden tapered porch posts atop brick bases support the porch and three diagonal sawn wood brackets highlight the main roofline. The one and one half story structure sits squarely on the lot; the exterior façade is narrow horizontal wood siding on the upper level, and wooden shakes on the lower. A plain barge board is found on the roofline. Two central interior chimneys are also on the structure
