Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B882

Corner lot. Small Queen Anne house nearly hidden by high, unkept hedge. Cross shaped gables on sides and a bay in front with fish scale shingle trim in gable end. Bracketed corners enclose three double hung windows of bay which has a shed roof over center windows. Small entry porch on left has wooden floor and steps. A wing on the back has a hip roof. Shingles are asphalt, vertical boards cover a high foundation and a water table divides house from foundation. The house is in rather poor condition.
