Statement of historical significance and description of property:

B911

This two story bungalow has a center gable, nine gable on right wing and the left wing is a shed dormer and sits on a cement foundation. The house has beveled siding and has an outside rock chimney in right wing. The door is off center in gable façade with vertical sidelights and is covered with a pediment. The tapered porch posts are resting on brick piers and the porch has a wood railing along the front of the house. A carport has been attached to the left wing. On the second floor, there are some double hung sash windows one-over-one. In the main gable there are three sash windows twelve-over-one. Downstairs in the main façade on the right-hand side of the door, they are twelve-over-one, fourteen-over-one, and twelve-over-one. In the right wing they are twelve-over-one. They are all surrounded by an entablature.
