- 3. **REVIEW REVISIONS TO THE AIRPORT MINIMUM STANDARDS** (Airport Administrator)

 - During the initial part of the meeting, which is not available on video, the Airport Commission participated with City Staff in discussing and reviewing comments that were made since the last Airport Commission meeting held on 7/5/2022.
 - A change was made, during the meeting, in Section 5.6.2 Fuel, that ensures availability
 of 100 LL Avgas and provides the option for all vendors to sell both Avgas and Jet fuel.
 - This review focused on additions, deletions, and comments made since the July 5, 2022 regular Airport Commission Meeting
 - New addition Section 7.2.1.1 for Mobile Service Maintenance Provider was discussed with no changes required
 - Significant modification to Section 9, Appeals was discussed with no additional changes required.
