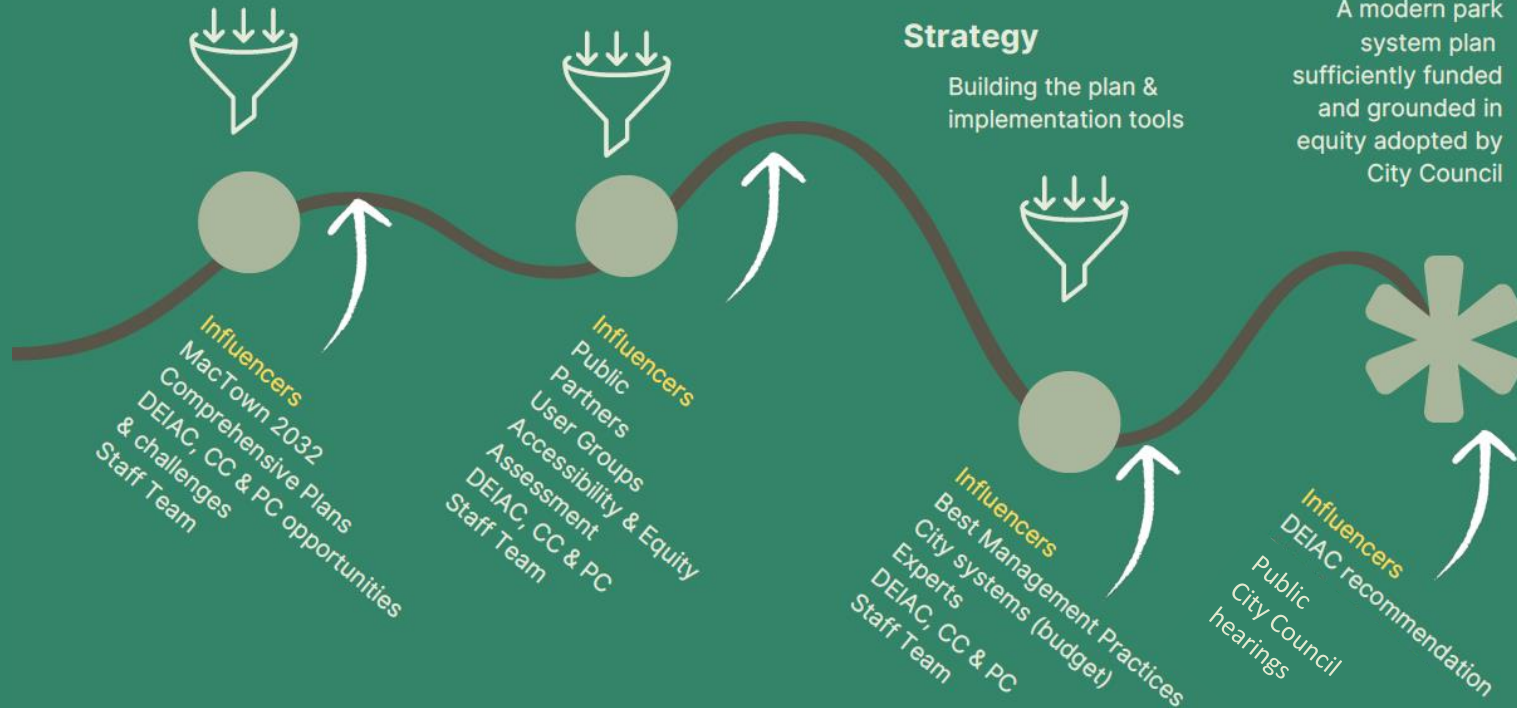

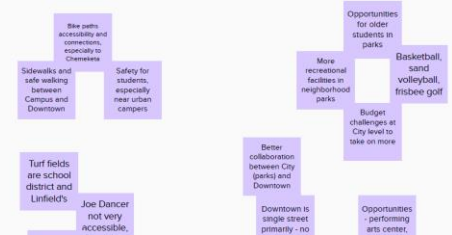

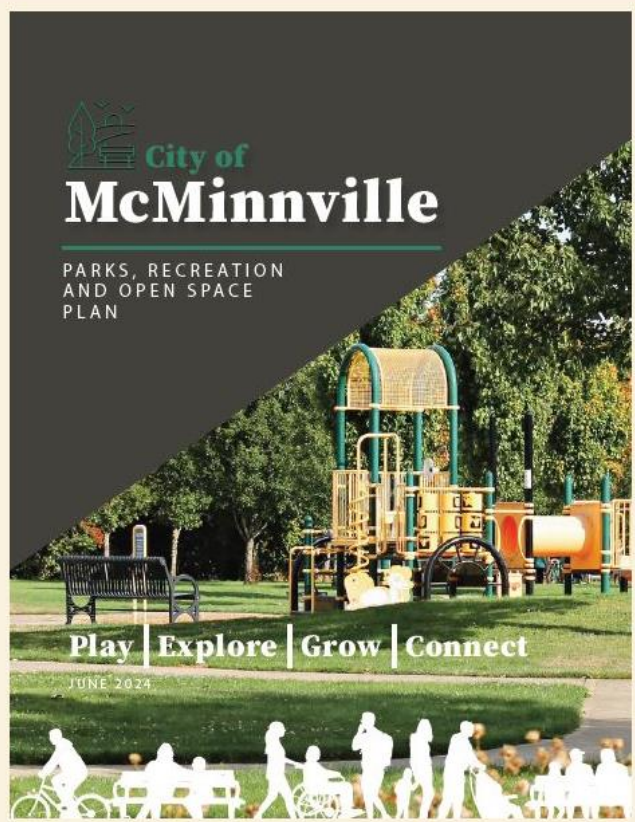
Council Meeting: March 2024

- 1999 Plan trail from Dancer to Linfield
- Additional Central McMinnville infill park
- Climate resiliency
- Security cameras and lighting
- High quality equipment
- Saving Camas plants
- Fitness equipment



Key Changes from Draft Plan

- Added new future infill neighborhood park in northwest central McMinnville and made a 5-year priority
- Added new future trail connecting Cozine Creek to Joe Dancer Park and made a 5-year priority
- Minor adjustments to short-term project list
- Clarified that staffing levels need to increase to accommodate expanded system

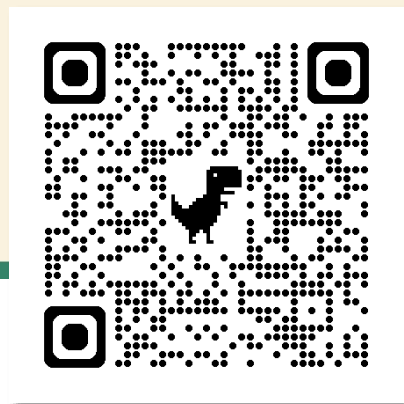


Final Draft Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Plan
