## **Initiative Process in a nutshell:**

- 1. Chief petitioners must submit at least 100% of the required number of signatures before the city recorder can begin the verification process.
  - Collect signatures 15% of registered voters
  - 2-year deadline to submit signature sheets.
- 2. If petition contains the required number of signatures City Recorder presents petition to governing body at next meeting, but before State deadline (*August 7th to file qualified initiative*)
- 3. City Governing Body Choices:
  - a. Adopt the initiative; certify the measure to the county elections official to be placed on the ballot at the next election
  - b. Reject the initiative; certify the measure to the county elections official to be placed on the ballot at the next election
  - c. Reject the initiative and refer; competing measure



## 2024 Local Elections Calendar - INITIATIVE

<u>August 7</u> – Last Day for City Recorder to file qualified initiative with governing body (both signature verification AND meeting of Council must occur by this date)

**November 5** – Election Day



## City Referral Process in a nutshell:

- 1. Council adopts resolution to place question on the ballot for the voters to decide.
- 2. Resolution is filed with elections official not later than 61st day prior to an election.
- 3. Council **may** prepare a ballot title for referral at same time as the resolution
  - If do prepare ballot title, submit form SEL 805 text for referral must be filed at same time.
  - If choose **not** to prepare ballot title, city attorneys prepares ballot title
- 4. City Attorney prepares ballot title
- 5. Publication of ballot title
- 6. Circuit Court Review of Ballot Title
- 7. City Recorder submits SEL 802 to County Clerks office
- 8. County assigns measure number



## 2024 Local Elections Calendar - REFERRAL

<u>August 16</u> – Last Day for Council to file ballot title or referral text

<u>September 5</u> – Last Day to file SEL 802 with County (*upon completion of ballot title challenge process*)

<u>September 9</u> – Last Day to file arguments with County for voter's pamphlet

**November 5** – Election Day
