

## Survey Key Takeaways

- This was community-oriented, not scientific like the May qualitive poll, but similar results were yielded.
- The Rec Center was identified as the feature most likely to be used by over 40% of respondents.
- Almost 70% of respondents "strongly support" the City moving forward with the proposal for May 2025.
- Over 50% expressed increased interest if they will receive lower-cost access than those residents outside the City.
