There was discussion regarding no overhead power lines, preserving native Oak trees, distance of the replacement trees, availability of the replacement trees and other options if they were not available, and how the replanting size should be two inch caliper.

Chair Hall moved to approve L 19-22 with flexibility in the tree species as long as it was a two inch caliper tree on the approved list. The motion was seconded by Committee Member Wicks and passed 4-0.
